Guitar Key Technical Words:

Chord: playing many notes at once (often all six strings)

Strumming: Playing all required strings in one go

Picking: Plucking the individual strings

Acoustic: a guitar that does not need an amplifier to be heard

Electroacoustic: a guitar that can work both acoustically and through an amplifier

Jack Lead: The cable that connects a guitar to the amplifier

Blue Note: bending the string to make a different note

Hammer On: playing a string with your 'fret' hand by striking down with a fingerPull Off: playing a string with your 'fret' hand by plucking the string with a fingerPalm Mute: stopping the strings vibrating with the palm of your strumming handPower Chord:

Guitar Notation (TAB)

- » Guitar tab notation is a way of writing down specific notes
- » It has <u>six lines</u> which represent the <u>strings</u>
- » It has <u>numbers</u> which tell you where to push your finger down on a string (which <u>fret</u>)
